

**ANNEX C: PROCEDURE FOR PROJECT PARTICIPANTS TO RESOLVE
DISPUTES WITH THAILAND RELATING TO THE APPLICATION OF
CORRESPONDING ADJUSTMENTS**

1. This Annex sets out the procedure by which a project participant may seek to resolve a dispute with Thailand relating to the application of corresponding adjustments.

2. Where a project participant is of the view that Thailand has not applied corresponding adjustments in accordance with Article 9 (Corresponding Adjustments), the project participant may raise the matter for Thailand's attention by sending the relevant particulars in writing to the following authority:

3. Within thirty (30) days of the project participant raising the matter, Thailand shall respond to the project participant, in writing, to propose a method to resolve the dispute.

4. If the dispute is not resolved within One Hundred and Eighty (180) days of the project participant raising the matter, the dispute shall be discussed by the Parties.

5. For the avoidance of doubt, the procedure set out in this Annex is in addition to any other remedies that may be available under international law, the national laws of Thailand, or any contract.
